LOMBARD, IL, Mayslake Ministries is offering “Coming Home” a healing retreat program for military veterans on November 11 to 13 at Cardinal Stritch Retreat House in Mundelein.

Coming Home is a Christian-based retreat program designed to help military men and women come to spiritual healing and reconciliation with God. The program is about Spirituality, not religion and specifically addresses the issue of Post-Traumatic Spiritual Stress Disorder.

This is a two-night weekend retreat offered to veterans and their significant other (should they also wish to attend) in a place of safety, respite and support. Retreat leader, Sr. Linda McClenahan, a veteran herself, served as a communications Sergeant in Vietnam. She is now a Dominican Sister and Licensed Professional Counselor and Therapist whose ministry involves helping veterans and others deal with trauma. Veterans of any age are welcome. While this is a Christian retreat, veterans of any faith tradition are welcome. The retreats are free to all military veterans. All meals and lodging are included.
