Frequently ASKED QUESTIONS

IS SPIRITUAL DIRECTION LIKE COUNSELING?

No, spiritual direction is not like counseling; rather it is a process of self-discovery and awareness to the workings of God in one's life. In spiritual direction, the spiritual director, with the help of the Holy Spirit, prayerfully listens as a person shares the joys and struggles of his or her faith life. Through this shared sacred dialogue, they discuss the action of God's abiding presence at work in the directee's life.

HOW IS SPIRITUAL DIRECTION BENEFICIAL TO MY FAITH LIFE?

In spiritual direction, individuals can heal, build and strengthen their relationship with Christ. Once a person experiences the profound joy of knowing Jesus, this encounter can be life changing.

HOW LONG DOES A SPIRITUAL DIRECTION SESSION LAST?

Individual sessions are usually one hour in length and occur once a month. Spiritual direction sessions are offered in person at our offices in Oakbrook Terrace, II. or remotely via Skype, Facetime or Zoom.
